ENTRIES:

The application for participation can be submitted by an individual person, club or the team captain who represents the specific Ski Association and the athlete. The application must be submitted by an electronic mail to info@infoski.lv to our race secretary. The registration must take place no later than 5 days before the race (according to Baltic Cup 2015 alpine ski competition rules, published in www.infoski.lv and www.kalnuslidinejimas.lt)

Every entry should include:

- Name, first name, year of birth, National Ski Association;
- An exact definition of the event and age group for which the entry is made.
- Contact information of the team leader or the individual athlete.

For the FIS SL races all entries must be sent according to the International Ski Competition Rules ICR. All entries must be sent so that the Organizing Committee receives them before the final date of entry. The organizers must have a final and complete list not later than 24 hours before the first draw.

Other rules from the ICR that has to be taken in consideration:

215.2 National Ski Associations are not permitted to enter and draw the same competitors in more than one competition on the same date.

215.3 Only National Ski Associations are entitled to make entries for international competitions. Every entry should include:

215.3.1 code number, name, first name, year of birth, National Ski Association;

215.3.2 an exact definition of the event for which the entry is made.

215.5 The entry of a competitor by the National Ski Association for a race shall constitute a contract solely between the competitor and the organiser and shall be governed by the Athletes Declaration.

NB! The FIS races will be held according to FIS ICR. Please note that the nations can enter their athletes only according to their FIS quota and the organizer expects no more than one representative per nation per gender as a team captain.

RACE OFFICE AND TEAM CAPTAINS MEETINGS:

Race Office will be located at Sigulda Culture Center located in Pils street 10, Sigulda LV-2150 <https://www.google.lv/maps/place/Pils+ielas+10/@57.1562959,24.8528713,17z/data=!4m3!3m2!1s0x46e94fcebffe2a43:0xf5f62979f85cd25d!4b1> and will work from Friday, 20th February from 18:00. The first team captains meeting will be held on Friday, 20th February 19.00 for the FIS ENL and 20.00 for U12,U14,U16 and the Masters race. Coaches are kindly asked to confirm their entries before the team captains meetings. Next team captains meetings will be announced at the team captains meetings.

ENTRY FEES:

Entry fee of – 15,- eur per racer per discipline will be charged. In FIS ENL races the entry fee is paid only by the athletes of the organizing nation. The entry fee has to be paid to the organizing committee at the race office before the TCM of the respective race.

LIFT TICKETS:

The price of a lift ticket in "Pilsētas trase" Sigulda is defined by 0,50 eur per run. For the FIS ENL races athletes and their team representative will receive free lift access according to the International FIS quota of the respective team and the valid start list.

INSURANCE:

Competitors compete on their own liability. National Ski Associations and team officials are responsible for adequate insurance for all their competitors.
